





### **EASTER TREE**

#### An Immanuel Youth Sponsored Activity

As you enter the Narthex during Lent you will find our Easter Tree. This tree will serve as our visual calendar as we count the days until Easter. The youth would like you to bring this tree to life by adding leaves and flowers to it each week as you reflect on your own lives and your relationship with God.

Use the **flowers** to express the things you hope will blossom or continue to blossom (answered prayers, forgiveness, blessings, thankfulness, building a relationship with God).

Use the **leaves** to express the things you need for growth and fullness (forgiveness, releasing worries, what are you seeking or wondering about, identify fears, helping those in need, find answers to questions).

- •What are you thankful for? •What blessings do you want to celebrate?
- •Do you have a prayer request? •Does someone in your life need an extra prayer?
- •Is there something you would like to be forgiven for? •Does someone need your forgiveness?
- •What are your fears? •What are you worried about? •What questions do you need answered?
  - •What can you do to deepen or strengthen your relationship with God?
  - •How can you walk with Jesus to help those in need? •What are you seeking?
  - •What is weighing heavily on your heart right now? •What are you wondering about?

As we journey through this Lenten season together, we are hoping this tree will blossom and grow into a bright and colorful reminder of our prayers, reflections, blessings, and thoughts that will lead us to a full, beautiful, faith-filled tree on Easter Sunday.
